

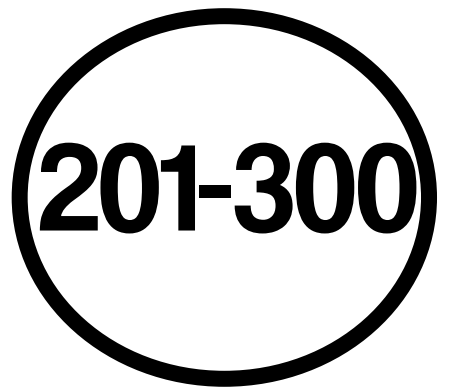
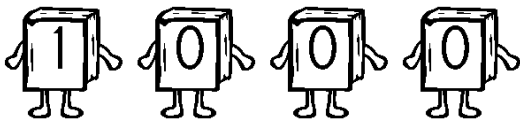
Books Before Kindergarten
