Our ongoing book sale will continue. With this new change, The Board of Trustees puts out the highlights of their revised donation policy:

1. Please only donate items that are in **good to excellent condition**. We cannot use items that have been damaged by water, mold, smoke, pets, or other critters, or have suffered from too much wear and tear.
2. Please limit donated items to those that are **10 years old or less**.
3. The following are items that we **do not** accept:
 - VHS tapes or cassettes
 - Board games, puzzles, or other toys
 - Textbooks
 - Dictionaries, encyclopedias, thesauruses, or atlases.
4. Please do not leave any donations outside the library. Books that are left outside are subject to water and pest damage. If a book is damaged, we have to throw it out.
5. It is the policy of the Booth & Dimock Memorial Library to accept gifts without qualification, and with the understanding that upon receipt, **all materials become property of the Library**. The Library reserves the right to determine location, retention, cataloging treatment, and other considerations related to use, display, or disposition of **all materials**.
