

Library Card Policy

The Booth & Dimock Memorial Library makes library cards available to town residents so eligible patrons can borrow materials from the Library's collection and use library resources.

Library cards are available to all Coventry residents, regardless of age. It is preferred that a parent or guardian provide a signature for those under 18. However, patrons 14 and over who are able to provide proof of address may get a Library Card, without signature from a parent or guardian.

A valid library card from a Connecticut Public Library is required to borrow materials from the Booth & Dimock Memorial Library while the BorrowIT program through the State Library is in effect.
