As many of you may know, the Booth & Dimock Memorial Library has been approved for renovations. The project is out to bid and construction is expected to begin in late Spring. We are very excited to move forward with this exciting milestone.

We are even more excited to announce that long-time resident and Library member Sondra Astor Stave has most generously donated \$75,000 to support this renovation project!
